

# **CONSUMER HEALTH DATA POLICY PURSUANT TO THE WASHINGTON STATE MY HEALTH MY DATA ACT**

Dated as of: March 20, 2026

This Consumer Health Data Policy (this “**Consumer Health Data Policy**”) is provided by **Ride Connection, Inc.**, an Oregon nonprofit corporation (“**Company**”, “**we**”, or “**us**”) to individuals who are residents of the State of Washington and have any of their Consumer Health Data collected by us.

Any word or phrase containing capitalized words not defined in this Consumer Health Data Policy is presumed to be defined in the Company’s Privacy Policy (the “**Privacy Policy**” or the “**Company’s Privacy Policy**”). This Consumer Health Data Policy explains how the Company collects, uses, and/or discloses information of an individual (“**User**”, “**Customer**”, “**you**”, or “**your**”) of the Services of the Company or of any of its Business Partners (as such terms are defined in the Company’s Privacy Policy) if such information is deemed to be “Consumer Health Data” under the Washington My Health My Data Act (the “**Washington State Act**”)

“**Consumer Health Data**” is broadly defined in this Consumer Health Data Policy, to mean personal information that is linked or can be reasonably linked to an individual and that identifies past, present or future physical or mental health status. Consumer Health Data does not include, among other things, data that cannot reasonably be used to infer information about, or otherwise be linked to, an identified or identifiable individual, or a device linked to such an individual.

## **HOW WE COLLECT, USE, AND DISCLOSE CONSUMER HEALTH DATA**

To provide the products or features or other Services offered by or through the Company and/or its Business Partners, we collect and process information about you, including information that may be considered Consumer Health Data under the Washington State Act. ## **HOW TO EXERCISE YOUR RIGHTS REGARDING CONSUMER HEALTH DATA**

Depending on where you live and subject to certain exceptions, you may have certain rights related to your Consumer Health Data. This includes the right to:

- Request that we confirm whether we are collecting or disclosing your Consumer Health Data (and with whom)
- Request access to your Consumer Health Data
- Request deletion of your Consumer Health Data
- Request the withdrawal of your consent for the collection and sharing of your Consumer Health Data
